- Pray and Fast for the week of January 29- February 2

### Why Prayer and Fasting?

- Prayer is intimacy with God that leads to the fulfillment of his purposes (Alvin Reid)
- Fasting was important to Jesus because he practiced fasting himself. Jesus expects you to fast as well. In Matthew 6:16-17 Jesus said "when you fast..."
- Fasting, according to Ronnie Floyd, is "the abstinence from food with a spiritual goal in mind or for a spiritual purpose."
- Fasting brings you closer to the Lord and increases your sensitivity to the Holy Spirit. It communicates to God that your desire for Him and His leading is more important than food and you trust Him to sustain you.
- Fasting is a way to say to God, "I long to see you work in your kingdom purposes" in your life, PVCC, the people and circumstances around you.

I believe Jesus knew that fasting is not about us somehow getting God's attention. Instead, fasting is about God getting all of our attention. And it is there, in the secret places of our lives where God has our undivided attention, that the reward of fasting comes to the surface of our lives in such beautiful ways. Clayton, Dave.
