




REAL CHRISTIANITY Gospel Identity


You discover your Gospel-shaped identity by experiencing the love of your heavenly Father

Your identity is your foundational sense of self. It is how you understand yourself, why you are here, how you fit into this big world. It impacts decision making & how you relate to others.



It is through your identity that you seek worth and value; meaning and purpose





Challenges to discovering your Gospel identity: Your sin

Ποιέω, poion = To behave in a certain way; to stay in a certain place. Related to the word

"remain." To continually practice something

- v. 29 If you know that he is righteous, you may be sure that everyone who *practices* righteousness has been born of him.
- v. 4 Everyone who *makes a practice* of sinning also practices lawlessness;
- v. 7 Whoever *practices* righteousness is righteous, as he is righteous.

- v. 8 Whoever *makes a practice* of sinning is of the devil
- v. 9 No one born of God makes a practice of sinning,
- v. 10 whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God,
