John the Baptist: Luke 1:80 And the child grew and became strong in spirit

Jesus the Messiah: Luke 2:40 And the child grew and became strong; he was filled with wisdom, and the grace of God was on him.

Luke 1:5-7; 13-15

⁵ In the time of Herod king of Judea there was a priest named Zechariah, who belonged to the priestly division of Abijah; his wife Elizabeth was also a descendant of Aaron. ⁶ Both of them were righteous in the sight of God, observing all the Lord's commands and decrees blamelessly. ⁷ But they were childless because Elizabeth was not able to conceive, and they were both very old.
